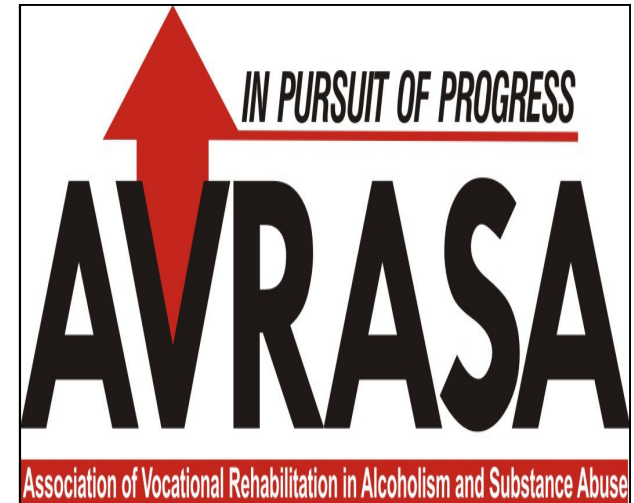

WHAT IS A REHABILITATION COUNSELOR?

A Rehabilitation Counselor is a professional who specializes in understanding the impact of disability on a person's life. The Rehabilitation Counselor plays a unique role in the recovery process as it relates to chemical dependency and other disabilities by helping individuals realize personal goals, and achieve their physical, social, emotional and vocational potential.



SERVICES OFFERED

Continuing Education Training & Workshops: AVRASA Members can attend training seminars to foster professional development and enhance skills in various interdisciplinary areas of Rehabilitation. CRC continuing education credits are offered for all training and conferences.

Clinical and Administrative Supervision Services: AVRASA Members who are Directors, Coordinators and Supervisors of Rehabilitation Professionals can attend training seminars focusing on peer supervision, education and training. Training is held in an interactive format on various topics such as: Strength Based Supervision, Grant Writing, Managing Supervisors, etc.

Job Bank Employment Opportunities: AVRASA Members can benefit from up to date employment opportunities in the fields of substance abuse, mental health, state, federal, and private sector positions.

Specialized Training & Technical Assistance: AVRASA serves as a clearinghouse for professional rehabilitation services. AVRASA can provide fee-based training on vocational rehabilitation, chemical dependency and co-existing disability services for the treatment field and private sector.

Professional Licensure and Certified Rehabilitation Exam Preparation: AVRASA offers training in New York City and Long Island for preparation for the Certified Rehabilitation Counseling and the Licensed Mental Health exam.
